

GENERAL FULL PAPER RULES

All authors with accepted abstracts are invited to submit a full paper for either an original scientific paper or a review paper, written in the English language, abiding by the following rules:

- 1. The whole text of the full papers has to be in Arial font 10.
- 2. Full papers margins should be 2 cm, top, bottom, left, right for A4 format paper.
- 3. Line spacing should be single, and alignment justify.
- 4. Use empty rows (space) between two paragraphs, and in no case spacing (Auto, 3 pt., 6 pt. etc.).
- 5. The submitted full papers (without the abstract) should contain no less than 5 and no more than 20 pages. Shorter, or longer length, manuscripts have to be discussed with the Publisher. No more than two manuscripts can be published by one author in one volume.
- Once completed, the full paper, alongside the cover letter, should be submitted to the publisher via the 'Submit Full Paper & Cover Letter' button, located at the base of the tab 'Authors Guidelines', sub-tab 'Full Paper Submission'.

IMPORTANT: The Full paper submission DEADLINE is <u>one month</u> after the date of the received Abstract acceptance letter.

Definitions:

ORIGINAL SCIENTIFIC PAPER - report unpublished results of completed original scientific research by the study's author(s). Experimental data should be presented in a way that enables reproduction and verification of analyses and deductions on which the conclusions are based.

REVIEW PAPER - synthesizes, summarizes, analyzes and evaluates published works on a specific topic. They are critical surveys of an area in which preferably the author himself is active. By organizing, integrating and evaluating previously published material, the author of a review article considers the progress of a current research towards clarifying a problem. Review articles range from entirely descriptive to highly evaluative.
